

Prof. Ilan Marek – short CV

Ilan Marek, born in Haifa (Israel) was educated in France. He received his PhD thesis in 1988 from the University Pierre et Marie Curie, Paris, (France) and after a short postdoctoral stay in Louvain-la-Neuve (Belgium), he obtained a research position at the CNRS in France in 1990. After obtaining his Habilitation in Organic Chemistry, he moved to the Technion- Israel Institute of Technology at the end of 1997 where he rapidly rose to the rank of full Professor. Since 2005, he holds the *Sir Michael and Lady Sobell Academic Chair*. In 2017, he was elected at the French Academy of Sciences and in 2019 at the Israel Academy of Sciences and Humanities.

He scientific interests concern the design and development of new and efficient stereo- and enantioselective strategies to create multiple stereocenters for the synthesis of important complex molecular structures.
